

- **From Schiphol Airport to Rotterdam Central Station:**
Best to take the train, train times etc.: <http://www.ns.nl/en#/>
Travel time: 48 minutes, or 26 minutes (Intercity Direct: you pay 2.60 euros extra)
- **From Rotterdam Central Station to Hotel Rotterdam:**
 - Walk, appr. 10 minutes, to: Schiekade 658)
 - Tram 25 (direction Schiebroek), 6 minutes, get out at: Schiekade)
- **From Hotel Rotterdam to Basque Kitchen (inside 'the Markthal' Ds. Jan Scharpstraat 298):**
Tram 24 (direction De Esch, stop Keizersstraat), or train (stop Rotterdam Blaak) or metro (stop Station Beurs). Travel time: 15-18 minutes.
